Attendance Matter

Autumn Term Attendance Headlines

The National and Lancashire target for attendance is 96%, our overall attendance is 94%. In the Autumn term we had 83 children who achieved 100%, which is very positive and not easy during the Aut term.

Unfortunately we have 57 children who are classed as persistently absent having attendance below 91%.

Class 7 were the best attenders this term with a wonderful 97.6% We had worked hard to improve punctuality, however lateness is at a worrying level with 177hrs (Iweek) of missed learning during the Aut term across the school.
